Motivational camp for 31 kids

A MOTIVATIONAL camp called Kem Janadiri was held for 31 poor children from Taman Prima, Selayang, last month.

The two day/one night camp, held at the Forest Research Institute Malaysia (FRIM) in Kepong, was organised by the Institute Advertising Communications Training (IACT Communications) with the cooperation of Pusat Janadaya (Empower) and Yayasan Kajian dan Pembangunan Masyarakat (YKPM).

The students were aged between 11 and 17 years.

They were exposed to team-building activities and a talk by Hyder Ali Naina Mohamed, a teacher by profession who has over 20 years of experience in giving seminars and trainings in areas such as smart study, motivation, positive

thinking, parenting, memory skills training and creativity.

The youths also played games which taught them qualities like how to work together as a team, to trust team members, time management and using practical knowledge to solve puzzles and excel in games.
