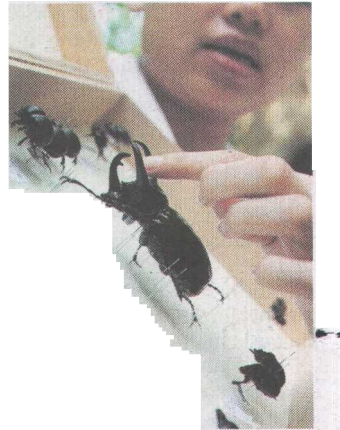

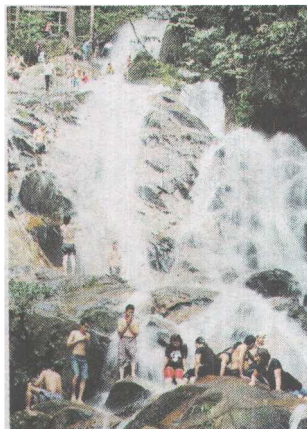
TOP three eco and agro tourism places



SUNGAI Congkak Recreational Forest is located 33km from Kuala Lumpur. The main attractions are the waterfalls and cool stream running through the forest. The forest is an idyllic retreat for city folk, who travel there to picnic, swim, camp, and trek.
