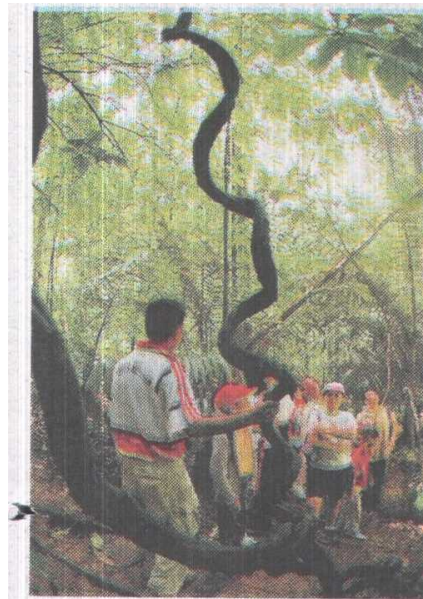
## TOP three places to visit



**C**AREY Island is famous for its great seafood and fine wooden masks made by the Mah Meri community, who are also known for their sculptures fashioned from a hardwood known as "Nyireh Batu".



**R**OYAL Selangor is the world's largest pewter company and acclaimed internationally for its exquisite craftsmanship. In recognition of its quality, the Sultan of Selangor conferred the manufacturer with the title of "Royal Pewter".



**F**OREST Research Institute of Malaysia offers a back-to-nature experience. There is a waterfall and river cutting through the forest reserve, which also has the remains of an old Orang Asli settlement. Four jungle tracks take visitors through some spectacular secondary jungle.
