KIARA Park TTDI, provided with multiple jogging tracks, stretching stations and playground, is surrounded by greenery and a man-made waterfall. The open area by the waterfall is perfect for picnics but be alert, as monkeys can be seen lurking around in the trees.



THE Kepong Botanical park is one of the most peaceful parks in the city.
