## FRIM patents green wood treatment

KUALA LUMPUR: The Forest Research Institute of Malaysia (FRIM) has found a chemicalfree technology to treat wood, which is via a high temperature drying (HTD) system. Director general Datuk Dr Abd Latif Mohmod said FRIM secured the patent for the system from the US Patent and Trademarks Office last March and had filed the patent in Malaysia and plus Singapore, Thailand, Vietnam, Indonesia, China and India. He said the new technology could resolve the dilemma faced by the wood industry in the country,

particularly rubberwood-based furniture manufacturers who are required to abide by stringent trade conditions to use environmental-friendly products. "This HTD system which can also treat other wood species, will potentially make Malaysia, among the first countries in the world to offer treated wood that are safe and environmental-friendly." He said in a statement more than 80% of Malaysia's exported furniture is made of rubberwood, which is also used by almost half of the furniture industry in Asia.
