Consequently, the local authority has sent its staff to be trained by the International Playground Safety Institute to become Certified Playground Safety Inspectors (CPSI) and Playground Maintenance Technicians (PMT).

"Eight pioneers have successfully completed the training to become CPSIs", said Dr Aseh.
