

Ulu Yam, satang Kali Ulu Yam is home to many waterfalls with beautiful scenery, such as the Sendat waterfalls. The Batu Dam, one of the key attractions in Ulu Yam, features an expansive lake surrounded by mountains and makes a gorgeous backdrop especially when accented by the setting sun.



The country's administrative capital is famous for its stunning architecture and landscaped gardens. Popular spots here include the Putrajaya Bridge and its sprawling 3km man-made lake, as well as in front of administrative buildings lit up with hundreds of lights at night.

Perdana Botanical Gardens, Kuala Lumpur Better known as just Lake Gardens, Perdana Botanical Gardens, is a perennial favourite. One of the oldest parks in the city, established in the 1880s, its sculpted and manicured gardens offer a welcome retreat



Sultan Abdul Samad building, Kuala Lumpur
The Sultan Abdul Samad building is the perfect
location for history buffs and architecture lovers, being a
pre-colonial building built in the late 19th century. With a
41m clocktower, its Moorish appearance combined with
British architecture reflects the rich cultural heritage of
Malaysia. The building overlooks the historical Dataran
Merdeka, where the country's independence was declared.

FRIM - Forest Research Institute Malaysia

Also known as the Kepong Botanical Gardens, this is another popular nature-themed site for a bridal portrait. The gardens are living plant collections and a showcase of botany, horticulture and landscaping. Its scenic ponds, waterfalls and quaint gazebos make a lush, green backdrop.



Kuala Lumpur Railway Station, Kuala Lumpur

Another historical building on the list, this railway station has stood the test
of time for over 100 years. It was the city's hub for Keretapi Tanah Melayu Berhad.
The station's mix of Eastern and Western designs is a huge draw.



Sekinchan
A small fishing and agricultural village, Sekinchan is well-known for its rolling fields of padi. The flat landscape and seemingly endless blue skies on a clear day are the ingredients for a beautiful picture. As the photographers rely on the season of the padi, wedding photo shoots here are seasonal but remains a top choice for many newlyweds.





Titiwangsa Lake Gardens
It is a popular recreational park in the heart of the city and a favourite spot for dating couples. Activities such as boating on the lake is an option for newlyweds looking for more romantic moments.



One would think that a university would be the last place to have a photoshoot, but UPM is a popular place for couples, thanks to its sprawling fields. One popular scenery is the field surrounded by white picket fences.
