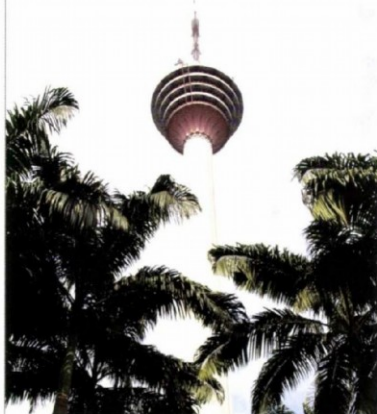
JAMEK MOSQUE

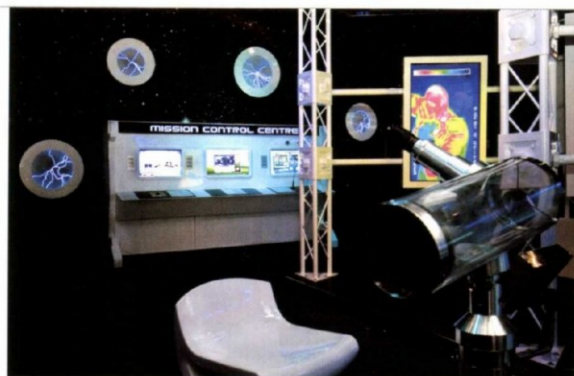

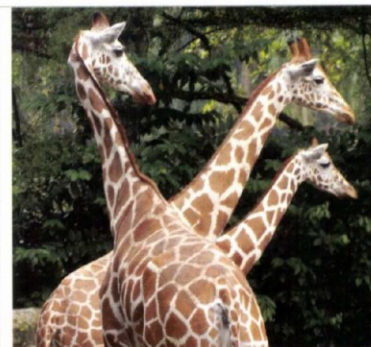
